


How do I create an account for Canvas for my Desktop Computer and/or on my cell phone?

Note: Parents can create a Canvas Desktop Observer Account only or Canvas Parent App only or both.

Option A: Create the Canvas Parent Account on your Desktop Computer



- Enter a pairing code to link your account to your student in the **Student Pairing Code** field.


